STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of fish in Hobbs Pond and its tributaries in the town of Hope, in the County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from 2 fishing or taking fish of any kind, in any manner from the 3 Hobbs pond, or any of its tributaries, in the town of 4 Hope, in the County of Knox, between the first day of 5 October, and the first day of July following, of each year 6 for the period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act, shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars 3 for the offense, and a further penalty of one dollar for 4 each fish taken in violation hereof, to be recovered on

5 complaint before any trial justice, or municipal or police6 court, in said County of Knox; one-half to complainant,7 and one-half to said County of Knox.
