## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to the taxation of real estate corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The buildings, lands, and all other pro-

- 2 perty real and personal, including all reserve funds,
- 3 accumulations and undivided profits, of corporations
- 4 organized for the purpose of buying, selling and leasing
- 5 real estate, shall be taxed to the corporation or the per-
- 6 sons having possession of such property, in the place
- 7 where such land and other property are situated, and
- 8 there shall be a lien for two years on such property for
- 9 the payment of the such tax, and the same may be sold
- 10 for payment thereof as in other cases; and shares of the

- 11 capital stock of such corporations shall not be taxed to
- 12 the owners thereof.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
