## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to confer the Right of Suffrage on Women in Municipal Affairs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Every female citizen of this State of the
- 2 age of twenty-one years and upwards who can read the
- 3 Constitution of this State and write her own name,
- 4 excepting paupers, persons under guardianship and
- 5 Indians not taxed, having her residence established in
- 6 this State for the term of three months next preceding
  - 7 the exercise of the right hereby conferred, may vote in
  - 8 the election of all town or city officers and in all the
- 9 affairs thereof, in the town, city or plantation where her

- 10 residence is so established, subject to the same pro-
- 11 visions and restrictions as to registration or otherwise,
- 12 as affect the rights of male voters at such elections.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
