STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of fish in any manner through the ice in Long, Cow and Greely Ponds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall fish through the ice in 2 Long, Cow or Greely ponds for a term of five years.
 - SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
- 2 of this act shall pay a fine of ten dollars, and one dollar
- 3 for every trout so taken to be recovered on complaint before
- 4 any trial justice in Franklin county, one-half to the com-
- 5 plainant and one-half to the county.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
