STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the Representation of the State at the World's Columbian Exposition at Chicago, upon the day specially set apart for the State of Maine.

Resolved, That for the proper representation of the 2 State at the World's Columbian Exposition at Chicago, 3 upon the day specially set apart in the year 1893 for the 4 State of Maine, the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby 5 appropriated, to be expended under the direction of the 6 Board of World's Fair Managers of Maine, in issuing in-7 vitations, decorating the State of Maine building at said 8 exposition, conducting musical and literary exercises and 9 defraying other necessary expenses connected with the 10 dedication of said building, and in the entertainment of 11 guests upon that occasion.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary, be, and is hereby ap-14 propriated for the purpose of paying the expenses of the 15 military staff of the commander-in-chief in attending at the 16 World's Columbian Exposition at Chicago, upon the day 17 specially set apart in the year 1893 for the State of Maine.
