STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to Chapter 137 of the Public Laws of 1887, relating to Disclosures of Poor Debtors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. If the debtor, after being duly served with 2 subpœna, transfers, conceals or otherwise disposes of any 3 real or personal property owned by, or any claims, rights, 4 credits or sums of money due said debtor, unless upon or-5 der of the commissioner issuing said subpœna, he shall not 6 be entitled to the benefit of the oath provided in section 7 eight of said chapter.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
