## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of trout in the tributaries of Parlin pond and Lang pond in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken from 2 the inlets of Parlin and Lang ponds or from Parlin or 3 Lang streams or their tributaries for the term of five years 4 from the first day of May, 1893.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars for 3 the offence and a further penalty of one dollar for each 4 fish so taken to be recovered on complaint before any trial 5 justice in Somerset county. •
