## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT limiting the jurisdiction of Naturalization of Foreigners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The supreme judicial and superior courts
- 2 shall respectively have jurisdiction of applications for
- 3 naturalization.
  - SECT. 2. No other court established by this State shall
- 2 entertain any primary or final declaration or application
- 3 made by or in behalt of an alien to become a citizen of the
- 4 United States, or entertain jurisdiction of the naturaliza-
- 5 tion of aliens.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
