STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn Horse Railroad Company to make a Loan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Horse Railroad

- 2 Company is hereby authorized to issue its bonds in such
- 3 denominations and such an amount, payable at such time
- 4 and at such rate of interest as the directors of said com-
- 5 pany shall deem advisable. The said loan to be made
- 6 for the purpose of equipping its road with electricity, or
- 7 for other purposes; and the said corporation is hereby
- 8 authorized and empowered to mortgage its road, fran-
- 9 chise and other property to secure the payment of said
- 10 bonds.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
