
AN ACT to change the close time on perch and bass in Hayden Lake, Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

On and after June 1st, 1893, and during the month of

- 2 June of each and every year after the approval of this act,
- 3 all persons shall be allowed to fish for perch and bass in
- 4 Hayden lake or Madison pond, Somerset county.
