STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to make valid the doings of the Town of Mars Hill, in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The doings and acts of the town of Mars

- 2 Hill in the county of Aroostook from the year eighteen
- 3 hundred eighty-nine up to and including the year eighteen
- 4 hundred and ninety-one, are hereby legalized and made
- 5 valid; and especially and particularly the following mis-
- 6 takes and defects to wit:

The constable who posted the copy of the warrant call-

8 ing the annual meeting in said town for said years did

- 9 not attest the same as required by law; and the acts and
- 10 doings of said town under said warrants are hereby made
- 11 legal and valid.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
