
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to Establish Certain Fees of Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In all cases where books with printed forms are not

- 2 furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall receive for
- 3 receiving, filing and recording any instruments under seal,
- 4 by law entitled to record, in addition to the fees now fixed
- 5 by law, the sum of fifteen cents for each hundred words,
- 6 or fraction thereof, in excess of five hundred words.
