STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to expenditure of School Moneys.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No moneys raised by towns or apportioned
- 2 to towns from the State treasury for the support of com-
- 3 mon schools, shall be expended in any school not wholly
- 4 and directly under the direction and control of the school
- 5 officers of the town in which said school is located, and
- 6 the discipline and the instruction of which is not mainly
- 7 in the English language.
- SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
- 2 with, except private and special acts, are hereby repealed,
