STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section four, of Chapter one hundred twenty-seven of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred seventy-five, relating to the place of holding the yearly meeting of Friends.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter one hundred twenty-2 seven of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred seventy-five, 3 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 4. The Yearly Meeting of Friends for New
5 England, a corporation established by the legislature of
6 Maine, is hereby authorized to hold its annual meeting
7 in the states of Maine or Massachusetts, from time to

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8 time, as they shall see fit, and transact therein any
9 business that may come before them, the same as if such
10 meeting were held in the State of Rhode Island or Maine.'
SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
