
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-nine of Chapter sixty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to change of Names of Persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows.

Section thirty-nine of chapter sixty-seven of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

- Section 39. If a person desires to have his name
- 4 changed, he may petition the judge of probate in the
- 5 county where he resides; or, if he is a minor, his legal
- 6 custodian may petition in his behalf, and the judge, after
- 7 due notice, may change the name of such person, and shall
- 8 make and preserve a record thereof.'
