STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of North Yarmouth Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and
2 hereby is appropriated annually for two years, to aid
3 North Yarmouth Academy, provided, however, that this
4 appropriation is made upon the express condition that the
5 trustees of said institution shall maintain and keep in
6 operation, for at least twenty-four weeks per year during
7 the continuance of this appropriation, a school equal in
8 rank and grade of teaching, with a first-class academy,
9 and provided further, that the governor and council and
10 superintendent of common schools, shall have a right at
11 all times to visit said school when the same shall be in
12 operation ; and if in the opinion of the governor and coun-

13 cil, paid institution at any time hereafter shall fail to ful-
14 fill the conditions contained in this resolve, they may in
15 their discretion withhold the appropriation herein granted.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is for the purpose of increasing the effective endowment of North Yarmoth Academy, and enabling the school to continue its usefulness until such time as its friends can raise the amount necessary to secure a sufficient income from its invested funds.
