**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE**

AN ACT to amend chapter 358 of the Private and Special Laws of 1893, entitled an act to prohibit the taking of fish from Webb's pond and its tributaries and outlet, in Franklin county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four (4) of chapter three hundred and fifty-two eight (358) of the Private and Special Laws of 1893 is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the words 'or from fishing in said pond or the mouth of any of its tributaries till the ice is broken up in said pond.' So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 4. All persons are hereby prohibited from taking fish of any kind, in any manner, through the ice, in Webb’s pond, in the town of Weld, or from fishing in said pond or the mouth of any of its tributaries till the ice is broken up in said pond.’
