IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to the Private and Special Acts, Chapter 554 of 1868, to incorporate the People's Twenty-five Cent Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That section one of said act be amended by 2 striking out the words, "Peoples' Twenty-five Cent

- 3 Savings Bank," and substituting the words, 'Peoples' Safe
- 4 Deposit and Savings Bank.'

SECT. 2. (Sect. 7.) Said corporation shall be authorized

- 2 and empowered to acquire, construct, and hold a safety
- 3 deposit vault and safe of such dimensions and capacity as

4 to accommodate persons desiring to make special deposits 5 of their valuables and property, and to this end may make 6 special compartments in the vault or safe for rent, at such 7 uniform annual or semi-annual rates as the trustees shall 8 determine by their votes; provided, however, that said 9 savings bank shall not be liable for any loss of property 10 deposited in said boxes for safe keeping beyond the sum 11 paid for the hire of the box containing said property so 12 lost, and providing further, that the construction of said 13 deposit boxes, and their location within the vaults of said 14 bank, shall be subject to the approval of the state bank 15 examiner, who shall make careful examination and certify 16 his approval to said bank before said boxes shall be 17 rented.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
