IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT to amend Section twenty of Chapter sixty-five of the Revised Statutes, relating to Assignment of Dower and Partition of Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter sixty-five of the Revised 2 Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words 3 "in the registry," in the fourth line, and inserting after 4 the word "and" in the same line the words 'the register of 5 probate shall make out and certify a true copy thereof to 6 the register,' so that said section when amended shall read 7 as follows:

'Section 20. The judge may set aside the return of the 9 commissioners, and commit the case anew to the same or

10 other commissioners. The return when accepted by the 11 court, shall be recorded in the probate office, and the reg12 ister of probate shall make out and certify a true copy
13 thereof to the register of deeds for the county in which
14 the lands lie, and be binding, to all intents and purposes,
15 upon all the persons interested, saving the right of appeal
16 to the supreme court of probate.'
