STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Trout from Marble brook and Marble pond in Blanchard for the term of four years.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, fish for, kill 2 or destroy, any trout or land-locked salmon, in Marble 3 brook or Marble pond situated in Blanchard, Piscataquis 4 county, Maine, at any time within four years from the 5 approval of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act, shall pay a fine of five dollars and shall further 3 pay the sum of one dollar for each and every trout and 4 land-locked salmon so taken, caught, killed or destroyed,

5 to be recovered by complaint before any trial justice or 6 municipal court, one-half to the complainant, and one-half 7 to the county where the complaint is made.
