## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Trout and Land-locked Salmon in Franklin and Oxford counties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. All fishing through the ice for trout or 2 land-locked salmon in any of the waters in the counties of 3 Franklin and Oxford is hereby prohibited.
- SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten dollars for 3 the attempt, and one dollar for each and every trout or 4 land-locked salmon so taken, caught, killed or destroyed, 5 to be recovered by complaint before any trial justice or 6 municipal court in the county in which the offence is com-7 mitted.
