IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.


AN ACT to prohibit the taking of certain fish in streams which flow into Anonymous pond in the town of Harrison, Cumberland county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from 2 fishing for, catching, killing or destroying any fish, suckers 3 excepted, in any of the streams that flow directly or indi-4 rectly into Anonymous pond in the town of Harrison in 5 the county of Cumberland, for a term of four years.

SECT. 2. All persons violating the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to a fine of ten dollars for the offense, 3 and one dollar additional for each and every fish taken,

- 4 killed or destroyed. The fines and penalties to be enforced
- 5 in accordance with the provisions of law applicable to the
- 6 general fish and game laws.
