STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of any fish from certain
tributaries of Sebec Lake.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall hereafter at any time take,
2 catch, fish for, kill or destroy, any fish in the following
3 tributaries of Sebec lake, in the county of Piscataquis, to
4 wit, Ship Pond stream, above Buck's Falls, so called, and
5 Benson stream and Long Pond stream, which empty their
6 waters into said Ship Pond stream. And no person shall
7 take, catch, fish for, kill or destroy any trout or land-
8 locked salmon, in Bear brook, or Mill brook, tributaries
9 of said lake from the tenth day of September to the first
10 day of May following.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten dollars for
3 the attempt, and one dollar for each and every fish so taken,
4 caught, killed or destroyed, to be recovered by complaint
5 before any trial justice, or municipal court in said county
6 of Piscataquis.
