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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, entitled "An act relating to the Herring Fishery in the St. Croix river.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Sect. 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and sixty-three 2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and 3 eighty-seven is hereby amended by inserting after the word 4 "driving" in the first line of said section the words 'and sein- 5 ing,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. The driving and seining of herring, in any man- 7 ner, except the seining of weirs, is hereby prohibited in the 8 Saint Croix river, between the breakwater at Calais and 9 Todd's Head, at Eastport.'
