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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to regulate fishing in the lower Wilson pond,  
Prong pond and Horseshoe pond.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time on the  
2 lower Wilson pond, the upper Wilson pond, Prong pond  
3 and Horseshoe pond, being the upper waters of Wilson  
4 stream in Piscataquis county, and all the tributaries of the  
5 aforesaid ponds from October first to July first of each  
6 year, for five years from the passage of this act. Who-  
7 ever violates any of the provisions of this act shall be  
8 subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars (\$10) or  
9 more than thirty dollars (\$30) for each offense, and one

10 dollar (\$1) additional for every fish caught, taken or  
11 killed in violation of any of the provisions of this act.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with  
2 these are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
