IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to close the tributaries of Upper and Lower Stone  
ponds in the town of Stoneham.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries of  
3 Upper Stone pond and Lower Stone pond, in the town of  
4 Stoneham.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act  
2 shall be subject to the same penalties provided for illegal fish-  
3 ing in the general law of the state.
