
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to the probate court in Androscoggin county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The probate court within and for the county 2 of Androscoggin shall be regularly held at such time and 3 place as the judge thereof shall order; and the sessions of 4 said court shall continue until final adjournment which 5 shall be not later than the day preceding the first day 6 of the next term. All matters requiring public notice 7 shall be made returnable to the first day of the next term. 8 Special courts may be held when necessary.

- Sect. 2. The salary of the judge of probate for said 2 county shall be eight hundred and fifty dollars per year 3 from the first day of January in the year of our Lord one 4 thousand nine hundred and one, payable quarterly, instead 5 of the sum now fixed by law.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
