STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT authorizing the Fryeburg Horse Railroad Company to maintain steamboats upon the waters of Upper Kezar pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Fryeburg Horse Railroad Company
2 are hereby authorized to maintain steamboats, steam tugs
3 or barges upon the Upper Kezar pond, Oxford county, for
4 the purpose of transporting passengers and freight to and
5 from a connection with the Fryeburg Horse Railroad, when
6 built.

Sect. 2. All the rights and powers conferred by chapter four hundred and sixty-four of the Private and Special Laws of 1897 are hereby continued, subject to the conditions imposed by the charter of said company, as amended by chapter four hundred and sixty-four of the Private and Special Laws of 1897.
