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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to incorporate the Trustees of Lincoln Lodge,  
number ninety, Knights of Pythias.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. E. E. Philbrook, F. W. Day, L. H. Chap-  
2 man, and their successors are hereby created a body politic  
3 and corporate, by the name of the Trustees of Lincoln  
4 Lodge, number ninety, Knights of Pythias, for the purpose  
5 of holding real and personal estate, and managing and dis-  
6 posing of the same for the use and benefit of said lodge.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may take by purchase, devise,  
2 bequest, or otherwise, any real or personal property, and

3 hold the same, for the purposes aforesaid, to an amount  
4 not exceeding five thousand dollars, and may manage and  
5 dispose of the same at the discretion of said lodge.

Sect. 3. To raise funds for the purpose of purchasing  
2 real estate, and erecting, enlarging or repairing buildings  
3 thereon, said corporation may issue bonds or stock to an  
4 amount not exceeding five thousand dollars, and secure the  
5 same by mortgage, if deemed expedient.

Sect. 4. Said corporation shall annually choose such  
2 officers as may be necessary for their own government, and  
3 have the right to prosecute actions in law and in equity,  
4 and adopt a seal and code of by-laws not inconsistent with  
5 the laws of the state.

Sect. 5. Vacancies caused by death, resignation or  
2 otherwise shall be filled by said Lincoln Lodge from the  
3 membership thereof.

Sect. 6. Any two persons named in this act, may call  
2 the first meeting of this corporation, by written notice,  
3 delivered or mailed to each corporator, at least three days  
4 before the time of said meeting.

Sect. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
