IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes relating to domestic animals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I of Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by inserting after the word "thereby" in the third 3 line and before the word "shall" in the fourth line the 4 words, 'or steals or entices away or confines or harbors 5 such animal for the purpose of obtaining a reward or for 6 any other illegal purpose,' and by inserting after the words 7 "five hundred dollars" in the fifth line the words 'and not

8 less than twenty dollars,' so that said section as amended 9 shall read as follows:

'Section I. Whoever wilfully or maliciously kills, wounds, maims, disfigures or poisons any domestic animal or exposes any poisonous substance with intent that the life of such animal shall be destroyed thereby or steals or entices away or confines or harbors such animal for the purpose of obtaining a reward or for any other illegal purpose shall be puntished by imprisonment for not more than four years or by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars and not less than twenty dollars.'
