STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to reports of hearings in vacation in law
or equity.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. At any hearing in vacation of a cause in law
2 or equity pending in the supreme judicial court, the presiding
3 justice may, when necessary, appoint a stenographer other
4 than his regularly appointed court stenographer to report
5 the proceedings thereof who shall receive for his services
6 from the treasury of the county in which the cause is pend-
7 ing a sum not exceeding six dollars a day for attendance in
8 addition to actual traveling expenses; but when at such hear-

9 ings the presiding justice employs his regularly appointed
10 stenographer, such stenographer shall receive from said
11 treasury only the amount of his actual expenses incurred in
12 attending the same.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
