IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to make valid the incorporation and corporate acts  
of Fort Fairfield Grange.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The incorporation of Fort Fairfield Grange,  
2 as effected in October, 1884, under the provisions of chapter  
3 55 of the Revised Statutes, edition of 1883, is hereby legal-  
4 ized and made valid.

Sect. 2. The acts and doings, as a corporation, of Fort  
2 Fairfield Grange, from October first, 1884, up to the date  
3 of the passage of this act, are hereby legalized and made  
4 valid.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
