## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-eight, of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, incorporating the Brunswick and Topsham Water District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter one hundred and fifty-2 eight, of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred 3 and three, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 5. All the affairs of said water district shall be 5 managed by a board of trustees composed of three members, 6 two to be chosen by the municipal officers of Brunswick, and 7 one by the municipal officers of Topsham. As soon as con-8 venient after the members of said board have been chosen,

9 said trustees hold a meeting at the town building at 10 Brunswick, and organize by the election of a president and II clerk, adopt a corporate seal and when necessary may choose 12 a treasurer and all other needful officers and agents for the 13 proper conduct and management of the affairs of said dis-14 trict. At said first meeting they shall determine by lot the 15 term of office of each trustee so that one shall serve for one 16 year, one for two years and one for three years; and when-17 ever the term of office of a trustee expires, the body which 18 appointed said trustee shall appoint a successor to serve the 19 full term of three years, and in case any other vacancy arises 20 it shall be filled in like manner for the unexpired term. 21 They may also ordain and establish such by-laws as are 22 necessary for their own convenience and the proper manage-23 ment of the affairs of the district. The term of office of 24 trustees shall begin on the first Monday of April, in the year 25 of our Lord nineteen hundred and three. Said trustees may 26 procure an office and incur such expenses as may be neces-27 sary. They shall make and publish an annual report, and 28 include therein the report of the treasurer. Each member 29 shall receive in full compensation for his services an allow-30 ance of one hundred dollars per annum.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
