### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE, in favor of Lee Normal Academy.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby 2 annually appropriated out of the school fund, for the term of 3 two years, to Lee Normal Academy, an institution of learn-4 ing located in the town of Lee, in the county of Penobscot; 5 provided, however, that this appropriation is made on the 6 express conditions that the trustees of said institution shall 7 maintain and keep in operation a school equal in rank and 8 grade of teaching with a first class academy, and in which 9 shall be given special and systematic instruction in the scionece and art of teaching; that no part of this appropriation 11 shall be devoted to other purposes than the payment of 12 instructors in said institution; that the superintendent of 13 public schools shall be ex-officio, a member of the board of 14 directors thereof; and that if in the opinion of the governor

15 and council, said institution at any time hereafter shall fail
16 to fulfill the conditions contained in this resolve, they may.
17 in their discretion, withhold the appropriation herein
18 granted; and the further sum of one thousand dollars is
19 hereby appropriated to said academy to be expended by the
20 trustees thereof for the repair of the boarding-house build21 ing connected with said academy; and provided further, that
22 said normal academy shall not be entitled to any aid from
23 the state for the years nineteen hundred and seven and nine24 teen hundred and eight in addition to that carried by this
25 resolve.
