AN ACT to set off part of the town of Bancroft and annex the
same to the town of Weston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

All that part of the town of Bancroft in Aroostook county
2 known as Trout Brook Bridge embracing lots numbered
3 sixteen, fifteen, fourteen and twenty-three in said town of
4 Bancroft is hereby set off from said Bancroft and annexed
5 to the town of Weston in Aroostook county.
