STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Bowdoinham.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Bowdoinham
2 the sum of seventy-four 70-100 dollars, it being the amount
3 deducted by the state treasurer from the apportionment of
4 school fund and mill tax due said town but forfeited on
5 account of apparent neglect to comply with the law.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On account of a change of superintendents of schools in said town of Bowdoinham the return of common school statistics was not sent to the state superintendent of public schools until after July 1, 1906, on which account the state treasurer deducted seventy-four and 70-100 dollars from the school fund of said town as the statutes require.
