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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE authorizing the Land Agent to release the interest of the state in the islets called "The Nub" in Bluehill in Hancock county.

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*Resolved*, That the state land agent be, and he is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered upon payment of the nominal  
3 consideration of five dollars to make, execute and deliver a  
4 good and sufficient deed releasing to Albert R. Conary of  
5 Bluehill, Hancock county, Maine, and his heirs and assigns,  
6 all the right, title and interest, which the state of Maine has  
7 in and to two wooded islands, so called, which lie nearest  
8 and immediately adjacent to the tract of land at Bluehill  
9 Falls in Hancock county called Mill Point; said islands, or  
10 one or more of them, being designated on the official map of  
11 the United States Geological Survey as "The Nub;" together  
12 with their adjacent and connected and outlying rocks and  
13 reefs to the line of lowest tide on all sides of the same.
