STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing and empowering the Aroostook Lumber
Company to erect and maintain piers and booms and store
lumber in the Presque Isle Stream.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Aroostook Lumber Company, a corpora-
2 tion existing under the laws of Maine, its successors and
3 assigns, is hereby authorized and empowered to erect and
4 maintain in that part of the Presque Isle Stream in the
5 towns of Presque Isle and Mapleton, in which the water is
6 raised by reason of the dam of said company located at its
7 mill in said Presque Isle, piers and booms for the purpose of
8 collecting, sorting and holding logs and lumber in said

9 stream and the flowage thereof caused by said dam, herein-
10 after provided.

Sect. 2. Said Aroostook Lumber Company, its successors
2 and assigns, is hereby authorized and empowered to store
3 and hold the logs and lumber destined for use and manufac-
4 ture at said mill, in the entire portion of said stream and
5 the flowage thereof in which the water is raised as aforesaid,
6 as hereinafter provided.

Said piers and booms shall be so located, constructed and
8 maintained, and the logs and lumber destined for use and
9 manufacture at said mill shall, at such times as logs and lum-
10 ber belonging to other parties and not destined for use and
11 manufacture at said mill, are running in said stream and a
12 way therefore is required, be so stored and kept as not to
13 unreasonably impede or obstruct the same.

At all times between the first day of July and the first day
15 of November of each year, logs and lumber destined for use
16 and manufacture at said mill, shall be so stored and kept as
17 to provide a passage way along the channel of said stream
18 of sufficient width for boats, canoes and other fresh water
19 craft to pass and repass at all places in said stream above
20 Michaud's Landing in said Town of Presque Isle; and at all
21 times between the first day of August and the first day of
22 November of each year, said logs and lumber shall be so
23 stored and kept as to provide a like passage for boats, canoes
24 and other fresh water craft, at all places between said Mich-
25 aud's Landing and the boat house situated on the east shore

26 of said stream, about five (5) rods north of the north line of
27 Lot numbered eighty-four (84), in that part of Presque
28 Isle Village known as Riverside.

Said Aroostook Lumber Company, its successors and
30 assigns, shall at all times run and hold its lumber, stored in
31 said waters, as near said mill as, in the exercise of reason-
32 able diligence, it becomes practicable.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
