STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Caratunk Power Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Cara-2 tunk Power Company, which were granted by chapter two 3 hundred and two of the private and special laws of one 4 thousand nine hundred and three, as amended by chapter 5 one hundred and thirty of the private and special laws of 6 one thousand nine hundred and five, are hereby extended, 7 for and during a term of two years from date of the ap-8 proval of this act.

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Sect. 2. Said company shall have authority to construct 2 and maintain its lines, poles, wires and fixtures, for the 3 transmission of electricity, along, over, across and under 4 the roads and streets in the towns of New Portland, New 5 Vineyard and Industry; also to generate and supply elec-6 tricity in said towns, subject, however, to the conditions 7 and restrictions provided in chapter fifty-five of the revised 8 statutes, so far as applicable to the use of said roads and 9 streets.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
