## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Brooks to retire its bonded indebtedness and to issue new bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The town of Brooks is hereby authorized to
- 2 retire its bonded indebtedness, by purchase or exchange, at
- 3 the maturity thereof in such form and amount, and with
- 4 such rates of interest, and payable at such times and in such
- 5 manner as shall be determined by vote of said town, under
- 6 a proper article in the warrant at a legal meeting; provided,
- 7 however, that nothing herein contained shall authorize any
- 8 increase in the indebtedness of said town.
- Sect. 2. To carry into effect the provisions of this act,
- 2 said town is hereby authorized to pass such votes as may

- 3 be deemed necessary and proper to enter into and make 4 any contract or agreement not inconsistent with the laws
- 5 of this state.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
