IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate Cambolasse Telephone Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. George F. Way, Charles E. Drew, Edwin L.
2 Buzzell, Elmer E. Haynes, William H. Lovell, William E.
3 Walcott, Francis Babcock, C. C. Allen, O. E. Emerson,
4 Taylor Goodwin, A. G. Haynes, C. P. Small, George W.
5 Thombs, G. H. Haynes, J. C. Speed, E. S. Taylor, A. F.
6 Cushman, Mellen Brown, Eugene Bruce, Charles S. Lind-
7 say and B. R. Adams, their associates and successors, are
8 hereby made a body corporate by the name of Cambolasse
9 Telephone Company, with all the rights, powers and privi-
10 leges, and subject to all the duties and obligations of similar
11 corporations under the general laws of this state, with

12 power by that name to sue and be sued, to have a common
13 seal, to establish all by-laws and regulations for the manage-
14 ment of its affairs not repugnant to the laws of this state
15 and to do and perform any and all legal acts, incident to
16 similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to con-
2 struct, own, maintain and operate telephone line or lines
3 anywhere in the town of Lincoln in the county of Penob-
4 scot, and from any points in said Lincoln to and through
5 the adjoining town of Chester, in said county, having
6 obtained consent of said municipalities, and said corpora-
7 tion shall have the right to locate and construct its lines
8 upon and along any public highway or bridge in said towns,
9 but in such a way as not to incommode or endanger the
10 customary use thereof; and shall have the power to estab-
11 lish and collect tolls on said lines.

Sect. 3. Said corporation is hereby authorized and em-
2 powered to connect its lines with those of any other tele-
3 phone company or corporation on such terms as may be
4 mutually agreed upon, or to sell or lease its line or lines of
5 telephone and property in whole or in part, either before
6 or after completion, to any other telephone company or
7 corporation, as provided by law or upon such terms as may
8 be agreed by the contracting parties, which sale or lease shall
9 be binding upon the parties; or may purchase or lease any
10 other line or lines of telephone upon such terms and con-
11 ditions as may be agreed by the parties thereto; or may

12 purchase, hold, sell and convey real estate and personal
13 property necessary for the purposes contemplated in this
14 charter.

Sect. 4. If the land of any individual or corporation is
2 taken under this act, and the parties cannot agree upon the
3 damages occasioned thereby, they shall be estimated, secured
4 and paid in the manner provided in the case of land taken
5 for railroads.

Sect. 5. The capital stock of said corporation shall be
2 of such an amount as said corporation may, from time to
3 time, determine to be necessary, but not exceeding the sum
4 of five thousand dollars, for the sole purpose of owning,
5 leasing, constructing, maintaining and operating the line
6 or lines of telephone hereby authorized and contemplated.

Sect. 6. Any one of the incorporators named in this act
2 may call the first meeting of the corporation by mailing a
3 written notice signed by himself, postage paid, to each of
4 the other incorporators, seven days at least before the day
5 of the meeting, naming the time, place and purposes of such
6 meeting, and at such meeting, a president, secretary, treas-
7 urer and directors may be chosen, by-laws adopted, present
8 amount of capital stock fixed, and any corporate business
9 transacted.

Sect. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
