STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Baring for \$108.52 to be paid to the town of Baring on account of State road constructed in the year 1906.

Resolved, That the sum of \$108.52 be and hereby is appropriated to reimburse the town of Baring on account of State road constructed in the year 1906.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1906 the town of Baring appropriated \$200.00 for State road work and expended the sum of \$217.05. The grading and surfacing on this road was done in June and July but the iron drain pipe used for the culvert was delayed in transit and was not put in place until the first week in November.

The County Commissioners inspected this work prior to November first and refused to accept it, giving as a reason that the road was not completed.
