RESOLVE in favor of the town of Hodgdon.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid to the town of Hodgdon,
3 to correct an error of the County Commissioners of Aroos-
4 took county in regard to the amount due from the State
5 to the town of Hodgdon for "State road" for the year 1905.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Hodgdon actually expended \$500.00 in the year 1905 on the State road, and was entitled to receive \$250.00 from the State, but by an error in construing the town report the County Commissioners of Aroostook county reported to the State Highway Commissioner only \$300.00 expended by Hodgdon in 1905 on the State road, and the town received only \$150.00 from the State.
