STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Myles Standish Rifle Club, of Portland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. James C. Fox, Will M. Fawcett, Silas B. 2 Adams, Fred L. Hayden, William Willis Goold, Howard 3 B. Chandler, Charles J. Perkins, Richard H. Crosby, and 4 all persons who are or may hereafter become associated 5 with them, are hereby created a corporation by name of 6 Myles Standish Rifle Club, for the purpose of establishing 7 and maintaining a club house in the city of Portland, in 8 this State, and of promoting and encouraging the art of 9 rifle and revolver shooting among its members; and by that

10 name shall have power to sue and be sued, and possess all 11 the rights and privileges of corporations under the laws of 12 this State.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may elect such officers as it 2 may deem necessary, and may take, hold and convey real 3 and personal property to an amount not exceeding ten thou-4 sand dollars and may adopt such constitution, by-laws, rules 5 and regulations, not repugnant to the laws of the State, as 6 they may deem necessary for the management of their 7 affairs, including the power to fix and limit the right of 8 members in and to the corporate property, and the manner 9 in which the same shall determine.

Sect. 3. The first meeting of the corporators may be 2 called by any one of the persons named in the first section 3 of this act, by giving seven days' notice of the time and 4 place of said meeting by publishing the same in any daily 5 paper in said Portland.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
