AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred sixty-one of the
Public Laws of nineteen hundred five, relating to the taking
of clams in Yarmouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Chapter one hundred sixty-one of the Public Laws of the
2 year nineteen hundred five, relating to the taking of clams,
3 shall apply to the town of Yarmouth in Cumberland county,
4 and said town of Yarmouth may fix the times in which
5 clams may be taken within its limits in the manner and sub-
6 ject to the provisons of this chapter notwithstanding any
7 limitations contained in its charter.
