IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Recorders and Clerks of municipal and  
police courts.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That the signature of the recorder or clerk of  
2 any municipal or police court in this state to a complaint,  
3 warrant, mittimus, writ or other document, purporting to  
4 come from the court of which he is recorder or clerk, shall  
5 be sufficient evidence of his authority to issue the same,  
6 without, in any way, accounting for the absence or presence  
7 of the judge of said court.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
