AN ACT to extend the charter of the Cumberland County Power and Light Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Cum
berland County Power and Light Company, which were

amended by chapter two hundred and fifty-six of the

private and special laws of nineteen hundred seven, are


hereby extended for two years and the persons named in

aid act, their associates and successors shall have all the

rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by

said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the

same purposes as specified in said act.
