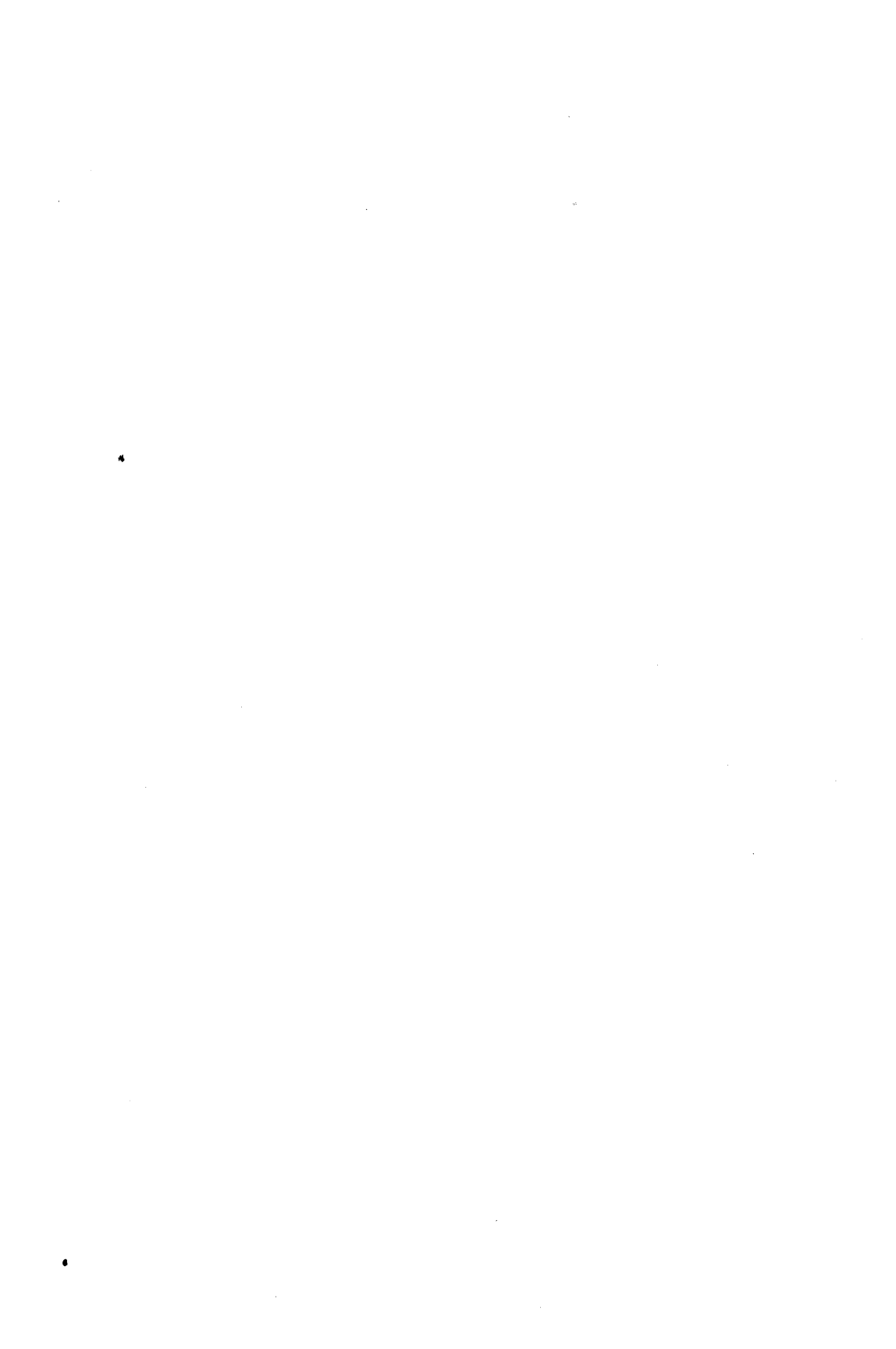

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of five thousand (5000) dollars to be paid to the St.
3 Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Orphan Asylum of Portland,
4 for the use of said institution; two thousand five hundred
5 (2500) dollars to be appropriated for the use of said insti-
6 tution for the year nineteen hundred nine (1909) and two
7 thousand five hundred (2500) to be appropriated for the
8 use of the said institution for the year nineteen hundred
9 ten (1910).
