AN ACT to prohibit seining smelts in certain parts of Casco

Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any 2 time to catch smelts in the waters of Casco Bay adjacent 3 to the city of Portland above Portland Bridge and Grand 4 Trunk Railway Bridge in any way except by the ordinary 5 method of hook and line.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall 2 be liable to a fine of fifty dollars for each offence upon 3 conviction.
