IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Merchants' Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Mer2 chants' Trust Company, located at Auburn, Androscoggin
3 County, Maine, which were granted by Chapter sixteen of
4 the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
5 seven, approved February 6, 1907, are hereby extended for
6 one year from the approval of this act, and George C. Wing,
7 John H. Litchfield, Seth M. Carter, George C. Wing, Jr.,
8 David R. Hastings, and Everett L. Smith, their associates
9 and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and

10 privileges that were granted by said original act, to be ex-11 ercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as 12 specified therein; provided, however, that said company 13 shall actually commence business as a trust company within 14 said one year. •
